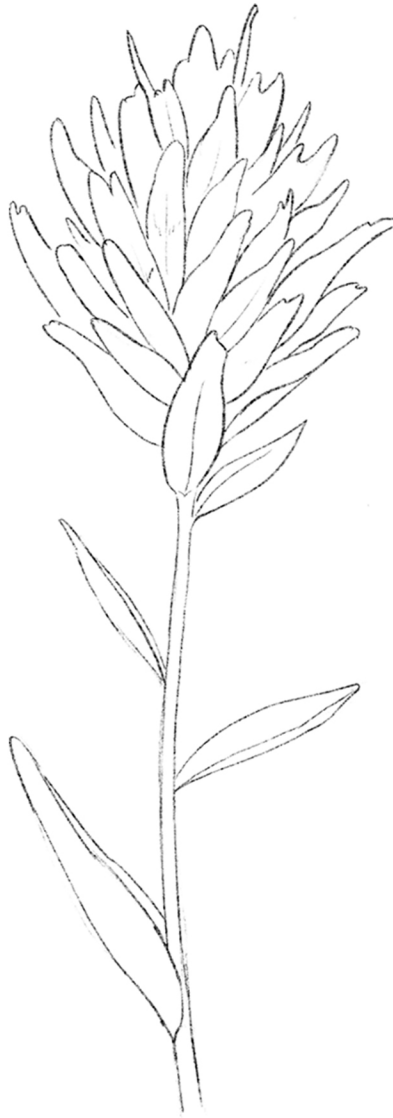

Colorado Wildflowers**



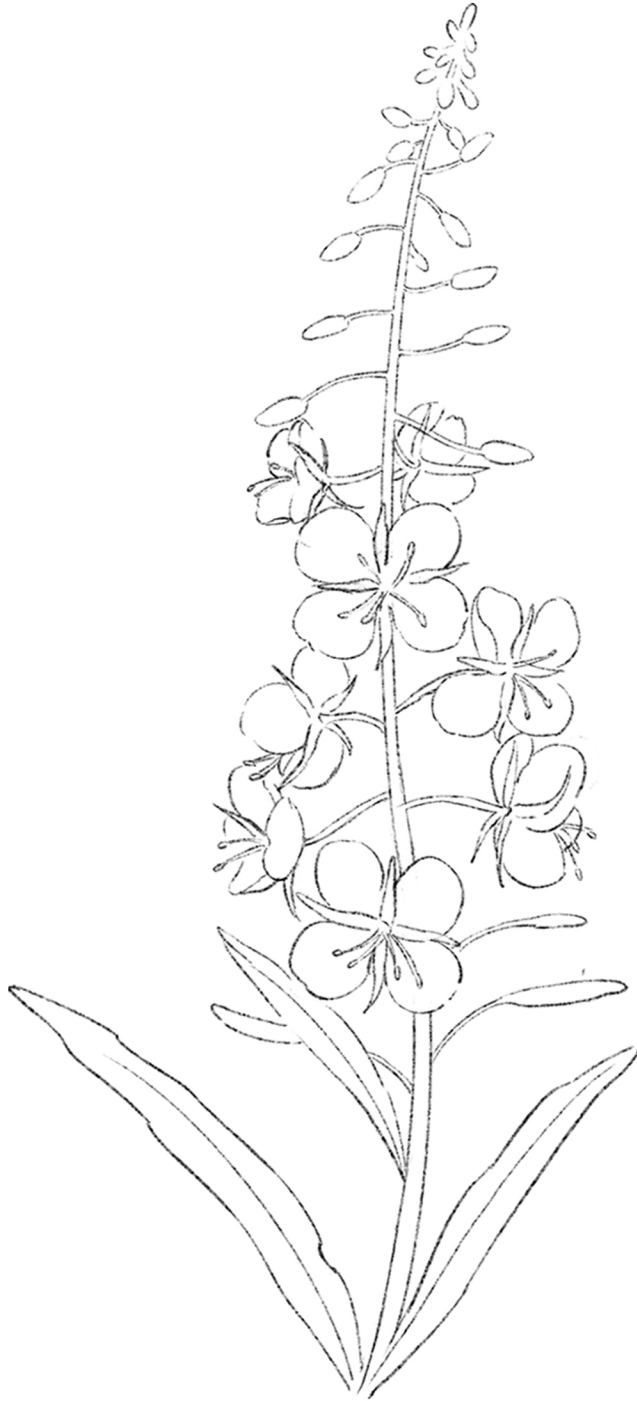
Mountain Harebell

**Late spring to early autumn in alpine meadows,
rocky slopes, and woodlands at 7,000-12,000 feet**



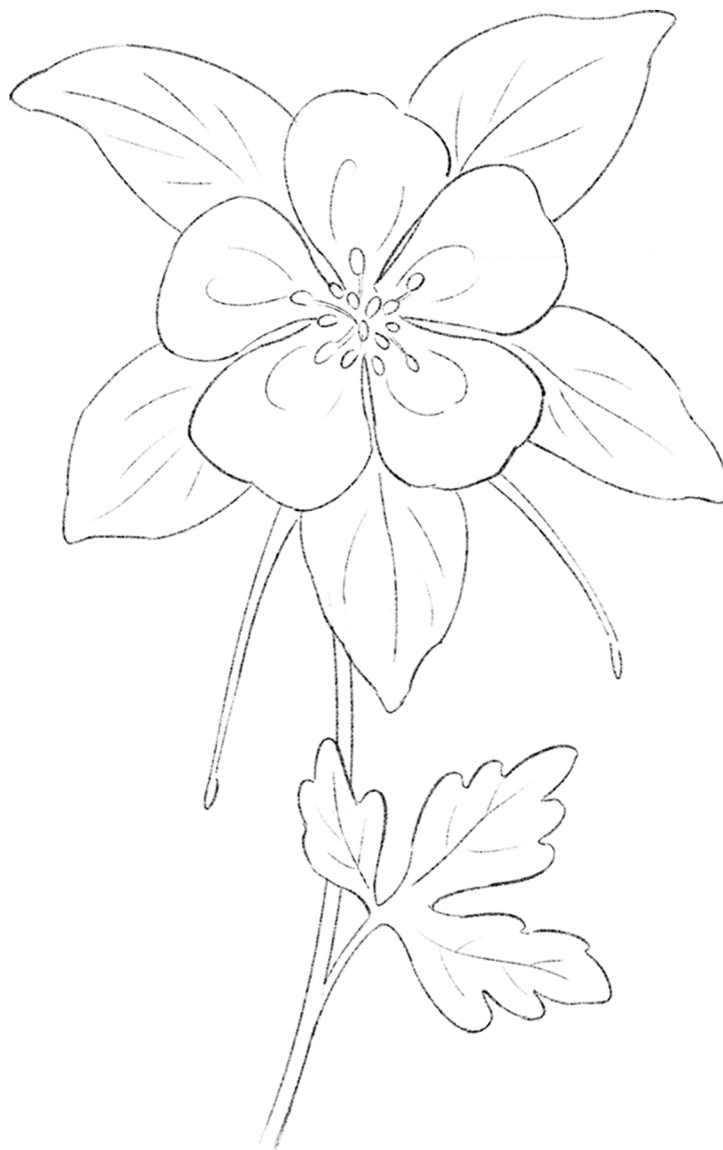
Indian Paintbrush

**Late spring to early fall in meadows, grassy slopes,
and alpine tundra across Colorado's mountain ranges**



Fireweed

Mid to late summer in areas recovering from fires, along roadsides, and in open woodlands, known for bright pink-purple flowers that thrive in disturbed soils



Blue Columbine

**Late spring to early summer in shady forests, meadows,
and streams, especially in the central Rockies**



Subalpine Daisy

Midsummer to early fall in moist meadows and high-altitude areas at 9,000-12,000 feet in the central Rockies
